SALHS year 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021

Over this period of 12 months **7** submissions were made to the media section of the website, an average of 0.58 articles per month.

This compares with items added during previous years **8** being submitted 2019-20 and **16** submitted 2018-19.

Important note

The decline in contributions since 2018-19 was foreseen and steps are in place to ensure that the media section of the website continues to receive contributions into the future; albeit at a reduced number of articles per annum compared to the early years of the society.
